Mosconi-Style Team Event

• Includes 2 Captain & 2 Co-Captains per team



1. Event Overview

The Dunagan Cup is a Mosconi-style team tournament featuring 60 qualified APA players battling it out across multiple team and singles formats in both 8-Ball and 9-Ball.

- Total Potential Points: 75
- Points Needed to Win the Cup: 38 team points
- Multiple rounds include scotch doubles, scotch triples, and singles play.
- All players on each team will be utilized strategically throughout the event.

2. Player Eligibility & Selection

2.1 Eligibility Criteria (Player Pool)

To be included in the **eligible player pool**, a player must:

- 1. Be in the Top 3 MVP in the Fall 2025 Session
- 2. Have played on multiple league nights during the Fall 2025 Session
 - (Example: played on more than one night of the week such as Monday & Wednesday, etc.)
- 3. Be in good standing with the league (standard league expectations)

2.2 Selection Process

From the pool of eligible players, the actual Dunagan Cup participants are determined as follows:

1. Notify eligible players via email

o Email notifications will be sent to all players who meet the eligibility criteria.

2. Open registration period (for eligible players only)

 Players who want to participate must register within the designated window (see Timeline below).

3. Random Draw from interested players

- A random draw is conducted within Skill Level (SL) groups to fill out the final rosters.
- This ensures balanced teams across all skill levels.

3. Team & Roster Structure

3.1 Team Size

- 30 players per team
 - o Includes 2 Captains & 2 Co-Captains

3.2 Roster Skill Level Breakdown (per Team)

Each team will be built to match the following **Skill Level distribution**:

- **SL 1–2:** 3 players
- SL 3: 5 players
- SL 4: 6 players
- **SL 5:** 6 players
- SL 6: 5 players
- **SL 7:** 3 players
- **SL 8–9:** 2 players

(Total per team = 30 players)

3.3 Captains & Co-Captains

Captains:

- Must be SL 5+ in both 8-Ball and 9-Ball
- Must have 500+ career matches played
- League Operators (LOs) will select 2 Captains per team

Co-Captains:

• Each team's Captains will **select their Co-Captains** (from the pool of participating players on their team).

4. Match Format & Rounds

The event is designed around multiple rounds, each with a specific format and scoring structure.

ROUND 1 - Scotch Doubles (8-Ball or 9-Ball)

- Format: Scotch Doubles
- Skill Level Limit: Max combined SL 13
- Scoring:
 - 1 rack = 1 point
 - o 5 racks total
 - o Maximum points available: 5
- Game choice:
 - Lagger's choice: Winner of the lag chooses 8-Ball or 9-Ball for that rack.

Participation Note:

Everyone must play once in Round 2 or Round 3.

ROUND 2 – 9-Ball Scotch Doubles

• Format: 9-Ball Scotch Doubles

Skill Level Limit: Max combined SL 11

Match Format: Race to 3Number of Matches: 10

Scoring:

o Each match win = 1 point

Maximum points available: 10

ROUND 3 – 8-Ball Singles

• Format: 8-Ball Singles

- Match Format: Race to 2
- Number of Matches: 10
- Scoring:
 - Each match win = 1 point
 - Maximum points available: 10
- Lineup Structure:
 - Lineups should be stacked from lowest SL to highest SL.

ROUND 4 – 9-Ball Scotch Triples

- Format: 9-Ball Scotch Triples
- Skill Level Limit: No SL limits
 - Teams must choose combinations wisely for balance and strategy.
- Participation:
 - Everyone plays in this round.
- Match Format: Race to 4
- Number of Matches: 10
- Scoring:
 - o Each match win = 1 point
 - o Maximum points available: 10

ROUND 5 - 8-Ball Scotch Doubles

- Format: 8-Ball Scotch Doubles
- Skill Level Limit: Max combined SL 11
- Match Format: Race to 2
- Number of Matches: 10
- Scoring:
 - o Each match win = 1 point
 - Maximum points available: 10

Special Note:

The 10 players that do NOT participate in Round 5
MUST play in the first match of 9-Ball singles in the Final Round.

FINAL ROUND - 9-Ball Singles

- Format: 9-Ball Singles
- Grouping by Skill Level:
 - SL 1-3: Race to 2
 - SL 4-6: Race to 3
 - SL 7–9: Race to 4
- Scoring:
 - o Each match win = 1 points
 - Maximum points available: 30

5. Scoring Summary & Winning the Cup

- Round 1: Up to 5 points
- Round 2: Up to 10 points
- Round 3: Up to 10 points
- Round 4: Up to 10 points
- Round 5: Up to 10 points
- Final Round (Singles): Up to 30 points

Total Potential Points: 75

To win **The Dunagan Cup**, a team must reach at least:

38 team points

6. Awards & Cash Prizes

For Both Teams:

Custom Team Jerseys

For the Winning Team:

- The Dunagan Cup (Yearly Cup) to be kept at the host location.
- "Bragging Rights" for a year!
- Team Plaque for winning team with picture and names
- Individual Medals for each player
- MVP Award to be awarded to the MVP of the team!
- Approximate value of awards package: \$2,200

Added Prize Pool:

- APA Austin to add \$3,000
- \$100 to each winning player (30 players on the winning team) from APA Austin
- \$50 to each winning player from Entry Fee 100% payout

7. Key Dates & Timeline

- Fall 2025 Session Ends: November 28
- Registration Opens for Eligible Players: December 8
- Registration Closes: December 31
- Random Team Draw: January 4
 - Conducted live on Facebook
- Event Date The Dunagan Cup: January 31st

8. Cadence and MVP Information

- The Dunagan Cup will be an annual event.
- The host location will alternate between north and south each year
- The session that we run The Dunagan Cup will REPLACE the standard MVP tournament for that session. (For this year it replaces the Fall Session MVP tournaments)
